About the Show!

Let your imagination soar as you explore through art, the contest theme, The Wonders of Water. When you think of water, what comes to mind visually? Chose your medium and express yourself!

Entry Rules & Dates

Eligibility: Open to all artists, ages 5-17. Artwork must be original two- or three-dimensional fine art. Two-dimensional work must be framed and ready to hang. Three-dimensional work must be free-standing.

One Entry per child, \$5 per entry: The show jurors will determine which pieces will be awarded prizes.

Awards: All participants will receive ribbons. \$750 in prizes and ribbons will be awarded, with one Best of Show; and 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each of five age categories. Honorable mentions may also be awarded.

Deadline to enter: Complete the entry form and bring it with artwork and payment to the Blue Line Gallery, 405 Vernon Street (first floor of Roseville's parking garage) on Saturday, June 7, between 1 and 6 p.m. or Monday, June 9, between noon and 4 p.m.

Pick up artwork: Monday, July 28, between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m., or call (916) 783-4117 to make alternate arrangements. **More details will be handed out when you drop off the artwork.**

Kaiser Permanente's New Women's and Children's Center

Kaiser Permanente's new Women and Children's Center will open in January 2009, bringing labor and delivery services to the Roseville area for the first time. The 174-bed center, located at the Roseville Medical Center, 1600 Eureka Road, will include private maternity rooms; an innovative, 48-bed Level III neonatal intensive care unit; private rooms for children who are hospitalized; and a dedicated pediatric intensive care unit. The new center features a soothing water theme that evokes the seashore -- the ideal place for a baby's first bath and lullaby. We are creating a nurturing, family-centered environment that offers highly specialized care for new mothers and children.

Roseville Arts' Blue Line Gallery

Roseville Arts' Blue Line Gallery, the new community center for art and education, opened its doors to the public in February, 2008. The 5000 square foot Blue Line Gallery was conceived by Roseville Arts in a bold effort to better serve a community that has sustained and supported its efforts for more than 40 years. Conveniently located in the first floor of the city's parking structure at 405 Vernon Street, the state-of-the-art space features exhibitions of international and national scope, as well as artwork by regional artists, with special opportunities for members, children and youth. In addition to exhibitions, the flexible space hosts a variety of workshops, meetings, hands-on art activities, small arts performances, lectures and more.
