Entry Rules & Dates

Eligibility – Open to all artists, ages 5-13. Artwork must be original 2 or 3 dimensional fine art, created since Aug 21, 2009, and never before exhibited at Roseville Arts galleries.

1 entry per artist – \$5 entry fee. Each child's entry is guaranteed to be in the exhibit and eligible for prizes. The show juror will select award winners.

Awards – All participants will receive ribbons. Prizes will be awarded for one Best of Show and numbered awards in different age categories.

Deadline to enter – Complete the two cut-off sides of this prospectus and bring them with artwork and payment to the Blue Line Gallery, 405 Vernon Street (first floor of the parking garage), 10-5pm on Friday, August 13.

2-D size limitations – All work must be framed and wired for easy and secure hanging. Anything larger than 26" in any direction may be rejected if space requires.

3-D size limitations – Sculpture or pottery may be no larger than 12 inches in any direction.

Pick up artwork – Beginning Tuesday, September 21st, during regular gallery hours.
