In memory of artist Marilyn Harris, Roseville Arts awards an annual \$250 scholarship to a graduating senior selected from the following high school districts: Roseville Joint Union High School District (Roseville & Granite Bay), Western Placer Unified School District (Lincoln), Placer Union High School District (Del Oro in Loomis), and Rocklin Unified School District.

### **Guidelines**

Scholarship amount--\$250.

Eligibility—Open to high school seniors, from the above-named school districts, planning to continue study in art after graduation and showing an outstanding record of achievement and school service in the field of art.

How to submit--Applicants must submit their requests on a *General Scholarship Application* form available through their school career or counseling center.

Deadline for scholarship application is determined by each high school district which will, in turn, submit all scholarship applications directly to Roseville Arts. (Generally April 1)

Letter of recommendation--A brief letter of recommendation from the student's art instructor must accompany the application.

Proof of enrollment in college within 12 months after announcement of the award must be submitted to Roseville Arts.
